Continued discussion on timing and feasibility of individual/community training ideas with ASAP's 2016-2017 Action Plan incorporated:

- Bystander training:
 - Possibly provide bystander info for alcohol overdose (Homecoming)
 - Green Dot Training – Helen Bagshaw will provide recap of her training experience at a future meeting.
- Tyler Eldridge (Drug Court participant) is looking to organize a talk, he could possibly coordinate a school assembly during Red Ribbon Campaign (Oct 24-28, 2016).
- Support Ruth Charles in promoting Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES) training in community in November 2016.
- Substance Abuse Prevention Skills Training (SAPST) – Bring volunteers to learn the fundamentals of prevention, and provide scholarships (Nov 29 – Dec 3, 2016).
- Incorporate Parents Who Host Lose the Most Campaign during holidays and teach about the consequences of heavy drinking.
- Possibly hand out educational material during sale at Fleet Farm to reach the hunting demographic.
- Identify and include a showing at the Frozen River Film Festival, possibly a positive community norm video created by students.
- Social norm campaign – Program Coordinator would like to bring volunteers to a [Positive Community Norms](#) training at the Montana Institute next summer.
